Cost of Trip: \$3,000

- Non refundable deposit of \$500.00 and application due October 15, 2013
- First Payment of \$1,000.00 due by November 15, 2013
- Second Payment of \$1,000 due by December 15 2013
- Final Payment of \$500.00 due by January 5, 2014
- If you require a visa, AOV will procure one for you. There is an additional fee of \$125.00. All paperwork for the visa and the payment must be to AOV by December 15, 2013.

Checks, Cash and Credit Cards accepted. If payment is made by credit card, a 3% fee will be added to the transaction.

Cost of trip includes airfare, food, lodging, transportation, translators and mission materials. It does not include the cost of immunizations, doctor visits and medications.

\$500.00 of the cost of the trip is Tax Deductible.

REQUIREMENTS

DOCUMENTATION

You must have a passport that is valid up to 6 months after the date of departure.

AOV will obtain your Visa, however, all Visa documents and a payment of \$125 must be turned in to AOV before December 15, 2013.

IMMUNIZATIONS AND MEDICATIONS

Yellow Fever is required and vaccination card must be included in Visa documents and turned in to AOV before December 15, 2013 if you require a visa.

The following immunizations are recommended:

Tetanus
Meningitis
Measles
Typhoid
Hepatitis A
Hepatitis B
Polio

Cipro and Malaria Pills are required.

Arrive in Accra and fly to the north region of Ghana to see the largest national park in the country. After an overnight in the city of Tamale, we will drive to the Mole National Park and participate in a 4x4 jeep safari as well as a walking safari with a park ranger.

In Mole, you will view West Africa's game like elephants, antelope, warthogs, baboon monkeys and buffalo.



Enjoy two nights at the Mole Lodge with a pool that overlooks the elephant watering hole. Also, tour the village of Larabanga with its historic mosque and mystic stone.



On our way to Kumasi we will visit the Boabeng Fiema Monkey Sanctuary. There are over 200 Geoffroy's black-and-white, Colobus monkeys and 500 Campbell's Mona monkeys protected by friendly local villagers.

Later, enjoy visiting the Menhyia Palace Museum and learning about Ashanti culture.

We will conclude the trip with the best part, serving the people of Yaw Tenkorang!





Yaw Tenkorang: Possible Projects

- Building a poultry farm: fencing, netting and building coops
- Concrete repair on the front of the Primary School
- Research and price out a new water filtration and storage system
- VBS and Field Day for all children
- Health checks for all students in the school and open clinic hours
- Distribution of clothing, bikes and other household goods to the entire village
- Work with teachers and students in the schools on art project
